INTRODUCTION

The 2024 ROLEX TP52 World Championship is organized by the Super Series Eventos Desportivos LDA in collaboration with the New York Yacht Club (NYYC), the New York Yacht Club Regatta Association Inc and the TP52 class. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the New York Yacht Club Regatta Association Inc. The host is the New York Yacht Club (NYYC).

The Event Sailing Instructions (ESI) give the 'local' instructions not mentioned in the 2024 NoR/SI and in case of clashes overrule the 2024 NoR/SI.

1) NYYC Race Week at Newport presented by Rolex & the 2024 ROLEX TP52 World Championship

The 2024 ROLEX TP52 World Championship is part of the NYYC Race Week at Newport presented by Rolex but primarily run under the 2024 52 Super Series NoR/SI and the 2024 ROLEX TP52 World Championship ESI.

2024 ROLEX TP52 World Championship Race Office, ONB and flagpole

The 52 Super Series / 2024 ROLEX TP52 World Championship Race Office, the Official Notice Board and the 52 Super Series Flagpole are based at the 52 Super Series container office positioned at the Safe Harbor Newport Shipyard.

NYYC entry (online) and registration

Teams competing in the 2024 ROLEX TP52 World Championship are obliged to enter the NYYC Race Week at Newport (as for the Annual Regatta), see 52 Super Series NoR/SI 5.2, as well as to register for the NYYC Race Week at Newport at the Newport Race Office, see the NYYC Race Week at Newport NoR 7 for the registration requirements. The entry fees for Annual Regatta and Race Week are included in the 52 Super Series entry fee!! DO NOT PAY TWICE!!

- All competitors shall submit a completed Crew Liability Waiver form before racing. This form will be available on the NYYC Race Week website.
- All boats shall pick up their NYYC Race Week regatta bags during the registration times listed in ESI 4 (in red). Registration will take place in the NYYC Sailing Center, Harbour Court, 5 Halidon Avenue, Newport, RI, 02840.

Two regattas in one, which rules when?

- The NYYC Race Week at Newport NoR and SI do not cover the 2024 ROLEX TP52 World Championship racing but do mention a ROLEX TP52 Worlds class start for the racing from Wednesday 17 July to Saturday 20 July as part of the NYYC Race Week at Newport.
- The 2024 ROLEX TP52 World Championship class starts are governed by the 52 Super Series ESI and all other NYYC Race Week at Newport starts by the NYYC Race Week at Newport .


4) RACE AREAS & VHF CHANNELS

Races will be sailed in the waters south of Newport, see map below for approx. position of the race areas / circles. **July 15 and 16 Race Area Alpha** will be the primary choice for the rendez-vous location and marks and courses will be standard 52 Super Series.

July 17 – 20 Race Area Bravo will be the primary choice for the rendez-vous location and marks and courses will be standard 52 Super Series.

The definite rendez-vous locations will be announced on VHF 72 at 0900 on each race day. Failure to make or receive this announcement will not be grounds for a boat to request redress (changes RRS 62.1(a).

The Race Committee will operate on VHF 68 (changes 52 Super Series NoR/SI 2.3, 15.5 and 16.1).

5) HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS & BERTHS

Boats shall not be hauled out after Thursday 11 July 2024 /18.00h except with and according to the terms of prior written authorisation of the class manager.

Boats shall be berthed in the same berths as during the NYYC Annual Regatta, unless instructed otherwise by Safe Harbor Shipyard.

6) NYYC RACE WEEK AT NEWPORT PRESENTED BY ROLEX PRIZES

Besides the trophies as listed in the 52 Super Series NoR/SI the Rolex TP52 World Championship / 52 Super Series start is eligible for following NYYC Race Week at Newport Carronade Trophy, which may be awarded to the boat that, in the collective opinions of the Race Committee Chair and Flag Officers, has the best overall performance in Race Week at Newport.

All trophies will be awarded at the Rolex Awards Dinner.

7) LOCAL RULES

The following NYYC Race Week SI rules shall be respected throughout sailing or racing at Newport:

- **Restricted Channels:** Competitors are reminded that Narragansett Bay and its approaches are considered restricted channels for commercial traffic and other vessels restricted in their ability to maneuver. Competitors must comply with the government right-of-way rules when in proximity to commercial or privileged marine traffic.
- **Newport Security Zone:** In the event there is racing in Narragansett Bay, competitors should be aware of heightened security around the Navy base in Newport just to the north of the Newport Pell Bridge. The area may be defined by a series of white buoys marking the Newport Security Zone along the coast of the Naval Facilities from Coasters Harbor to the breakwater at the north end of Coddington Cove and the line defined by the buoys shall rank as an obstruction. Yachts shall not enter this area. A Navy patrol boat monitors the area and vessels navigating in the Exclusionary Zone may face action by Coast Guard and Naval authorities.
- **Additional Restricted Areas:** There may be additional restricted areas due to Navy activity, shipping or fishing operations may be described in an amendment.
